



# Care Guide

## Introduction

Our laminates and decorative panels offer strength and durability while looking great in your home or office. With proper care and maintenance, you can extend their lifespan and keep them in excellent condition.

## Cleaning Recommendations

Cleaning decorative surfaces can help maintain its appearance and functionality. Proper care and maintenance of your decorative surfaces will not only preserve its aesthetic appeal but also extend its lifespan. Regular, gentle cleaning, along with precautions to prevent damage, are essential for keeping the surfaces in great condition. Here are some general cleaning recommendations for your surfaces:

1. Regular Dusting: Start by regularly dusting the surface with a soft, lint-free cloth or feather duster too remove loose dirt and debris. (see Figure A-1)

2. Non-abrasive cleaner and water: For general cleaning, prepare a solution of warm water and a mild non-abrasive cleaner. Soak a soft, clean cloth or sponge in the mild, diluted soapy water mixture. Wring it out so that it is damp but not soaking wet. (see Figure B-1)

\* be cautious not to oversaturate the surface. Prolonged exposure to prevent water spots can potentially affect the surface. Always dry the surface promptly after cleaning using a dried, clean and soft cloth.

3. Avoid Harsh Chemicals: Never use abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or solvents, as these can damage the thermoplastic layer. This includes bleach, acetone, ammonia, polishes, waxes, steam cleaning tools, or products containing acetone.

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
