## **Use & Care**

- > Avoid using the surface as a chopping, slicing, or hammering surface: NX Neumatte- Supermatte are not designed for cutting or pounding, so always use a proper cutting board or suitable surface to protect them.
- > Avoid exposing to high temperatures: Prolonged exposure to temperatures exceeding 60 °C (140 °F) can lead to laminate separation from the substrate. Be mindful of heat sources and use protective measures when necessary.
- > Refrain from using sharp tools: To prevent scratches or damage, do not use knives, box-cutters, or other sharp objects directly on NX Neumatte- Supermatte surface. Instead, use appropriate cutting surfaces.
- Prevent water-related issues: Do not flood the laminate surface and take care not to introduce water at joints or seams to prevent substrate expansion and potential damage.
